

CLAIM YOUR CME

APA CME Credit Claiming Link: <https://education.psychiatry.org/Users/InvitationCode.aspx>

At the conclusion of the course, physician participants will be provided with a link to claim hours of participation and receive an official CME certificate by completing an online CME course evaluation.

Non-physician participants can also receive a certificate of participation. At the conclusion of the conference, participants should complete the online conference evaluation in order to print a certificate of attendance. Follow the instructions above but select "Certificate of Participation" as your certificate type.

2. Log in with your APA username and password or create a new account
3. Enter the Invitation code: B7XUI68Z881 and click "Enroll"
4. Click "Get Started". The activity evaluation will open in a new window.
5. Complete the evaluation and click "Submit".
6. On the next page, click "Claim Credits". Select the number of credits from the drop-down menu and click "Claim".
7. Click "Continue" to close the course window. On the next screen, Click "Download Certificate". Certificate will be downloaded as a PDF file. Click the PDF file and print or save your Certificate.
